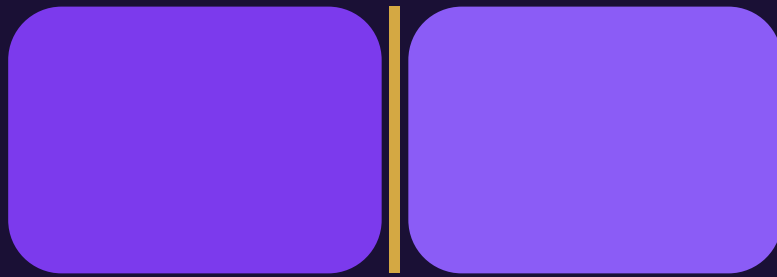

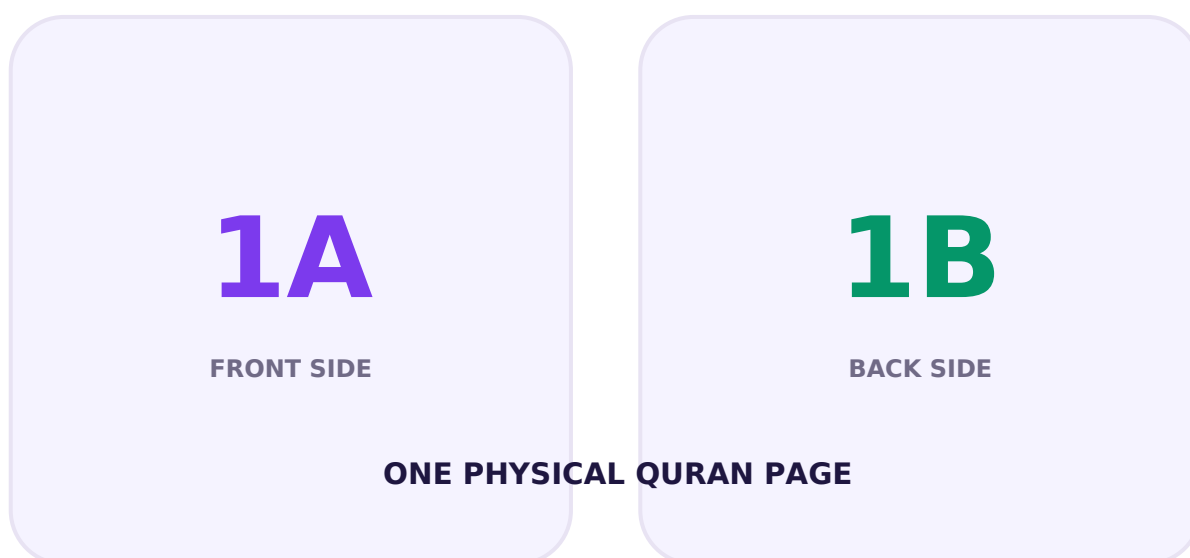
A slow visual guide to the A/B page system, 4-rakat revision plan, and Ayah references.

First: what one page means

In your DEENUNA Quran, A and B are not two different pages. They are the front and back of one physical Quran page.



1A + 1B = ONE FULL PAGE = ONE RAKAT

4 RAKATS

4 full pages in one Salah section

3 SECTIONS

Quran A, Quran B and Quran C

25 DAYS

100 full pages in each section

FULL PLAN

300 full pages / 600 A-B labels

Second: how labels become rakats

Read labels in pairs. Every pair is one complete page, and every complete page is one rakat.

The first four rakats

1A + 1B

RAKAT 1

DO NOT RUSH

Finish the current A/B pair before moving to the next rakat. One full page at a time makes Dor calm and clear.

ONE DAY, ONE CLEAR ROUTINE

Quran A follows Zohr. Quran B follows Maghrib. Quran C follows Esha. The app gives the Ayah reference for each pair.

Fourth: how the month grows

The labels move forward by four full pages per section every active day. You do not calculate it; the calendar does it for you.

DAY 1

A: 1A-4B

B: 101A-104B

C: 201A-204B

DAY 2

A: 5A-8B

B: 105A-108B

C: 205A-208B

DAY 25

A: 97A-100B

B: 197A-200B

C: 297A-300B

The monthly picture

8 labels

per section each active day

4 full pages

per section each active day

100 pages

per section in 25 days

300 pages

across Quran A, B and C

Fifth: use the Ayah Guide

The 15-Line Ayah Guide removes guessing. It tells you exactly where the standard reference page starts and ends.

1**OPEN THE GUIDE**

Open it from Dor Calendar or the feature grid.

2**ENTER THE PAGE**

Type the 15-line reference page number from 1 to 604.

3**READ THE RANGE**

See the starting and ending Surah/Ayah.

4**RETURN TO DOR**

Read the A/B pair, then mark your tracker honestly.

THE REAL PURPOSE OF DOR

Dor is not a race through labels. It is a calm, steady way to keep the Quran familiar, loved and strong in your heart.
